First, we want to acknowledge that we could not afford to find a perfect venue or provide our dream vision of a fully accessible event. We will always be seeking to do better year after year.

General accessibility information about the venue and event:

- The back entrance has a 1 inch lip in front of the door and can accommodate an electric wheelchair; those using a manual wheelchair or walker may require physical assistance, which we can provide.
- The bathroom on the first level is almost ADA compliant, but is a few inches shy of compliance; folks with electric wheelchairs have found it usable. Please let us know if you would like exact dimensions.
- There is an upstairs, but it will not be used for workshops, only play space overflow.
- There may not be any specifically designated low-stimuli spaces as the space is quite small and all parts of the venue are subject to sound and lighting coming from the rest of the building. However, there is a back parking lot that may be able to house a low-stimuli tent if needed.
- Workshops will only have sign language interpreters if requested as an accessibility need.
- All meals will be gluten-free, but if you have celiac, please let us know.

We will do everything in our power to meet accessibility requests. Thank you for sharing your needs with us as it will make us better equipped to serve our diverse community in the future.
